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Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

California Intercontinental University (CIU) offers relevant accredited online programs designed to enhance each student's professional career and is committed to equip business professionals, leaders, and entrepreneurs with the confidence, qualifications, and competence to succeed in the global business community and economy.

CIU is a business University focusing on Entrepreneurship, Global Business, Healthcare, Information Technology, and Project Management.

As of 2018, the associate and doctorate programs at CIU met or exceeded the Graduation Rate Benchmarks as set by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC). The graduation rates for the bachelor and master programs are showing continued improvement as the University strives to enhance the student experience in the classroom by updating programmatic curricula, recruiting exceptional faculty, and offering strong student support services. In June 2019, the university received approval to begin offering Title IV funding to eligible students enrolling in the associate degree programs and expect that enrollment will grow as a result. In summary, all of our degree-granting programs are now eligible for Title IV funding.
