Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

California Intercontinental University (CIU) offers relevant accredited online programs designed to enhance each student's professional career and is committed to equip business professionals, leaders, and entrepreneurs with the confidence, qualifications, and competence to succeed in the global business community and economy.

CIU is a business University focusing on Entrepreneurship, Global Business, Healthcare, Information Technology, and Project Management. California Intercontinental University offers four degree levels: associate, bachelor's, master's, and doctorate. Each degree level offers various business-related disciplines as areas of emphasis.

As of 2024, the master's and doctoral degree programs have met the graduation targets established by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC). The master's program has exceeded the benchmark by ten percentage points. However, the associate's and bachelor's degree programs fell short of the DEAC's graduation benchmarks.

On May 19, 2023, CIU was approved by DEAC to create specializations for its existing programs. Prior to adding specialization to each degree level, the institution offered 21 programs. After specializations were added to CIU programs, it condensed its programs to a total of 6, which is why the institution has reflected these updates in this year's graduation rates percentages.
