Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

California Intercontinental University (CIU) offers relevant accredited online programs designed to enhance each student's professional career and is committed to equip business professionals, leaders, and entrepreneurs with the confidence, qualifications, and competence to succeed in the global business community and economy.

CIU is a business University focusing on Entrepreneurship, Global Business, Healthcare, Information Technology, and Project Management. California Intercontinental University offers four degree levels: associate, bachelor's, master's, and doctorate. Each degree level offers various business-related disciplines as areas of emphasis.

As of 2023, the associate degree programs have surpassed the graduation targets established by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC) by ten percentage points. However, the bachelor's degree programs fell short of the DEAC's graduation benchmarks.

Similarly, the master's degree programs did not meet the DEAC's graduation benchmarks, whereas the doctorate-level programs exceeded these benchmarks by ten points.

In general, the University remains committed to enhancing student retention to drive ongoing improvements in graduation rates from year to year.
