Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

California Intercontinental University (CIU) offers relevant, accredited online programs to enhance each student's professional career. It is committed to equipping business professionals, leaders, and entrepreneurs with confidence, qualifications, and competence to succeed in the global business community and economy.

CIU is a business university focusing on entrepreneurship, global business, healthcare, information technology, and project management. California Intercontinental University offers four degree levels: associate, bachelor's, master's, and doctorate. Each degree level offers various business-related disciplines as areas of emphasis.

As of 2024, the associate, bachelor's, and doctoral degree programs **did not meet** the graduation benchmarks the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC) set forth. The master's degree programs **exceeded** the DEAC benchmark by 26%.

Overall, the University continues to focus on improving student retention and program pacing to support year-over-year improvement in graduation outcomes.
